

RENATA CEBULAR

“SERENADE to the STARS”

Victor Vasarely once stated that, “Every form is a base for color, every color is the attribute of a form.” Along these lines, Contemporary Swiss-Croatian artist Renata Cebular exquisitely illuminates images wrought from her imagination in lieu of simply reproducing the detectable. The results are brilliantly creative, aesthetically intriguing works of art which delightfully stir the senses.

Ms. Cebular expresses “the complexity and the diversity of nature” through her canvases of clean line and bold color. Her striking artwork is bursting with brilliant color and teeming with a delicate tension of form. Ms. Cebular uses bold black line to draw swirling designs filled in with vivid colors such as grass green, canary yellow and pumpkin orange. The whirling illustrations, in addition to the use of vibrant hues, convey a sense of motion and activity. Her buoyant images are at the edge of abstraction, appearing to be at the brink of morphing into an easily identifiable thing, such as a kaleidoscopic flower, thus allowing the spectator to individually determine what they see and feel from the artwork. Ms. Cebular’s adroit skill with the mediums of pencil and pen are particularly evident when one looks closely at her artwork and the intricate mesh of lines come into view as an assemblage of precise squares which constitute the dazzling image at large. The overlapping lines and colors give the sensation of a glorious fabric being woven from the myriad of chromatic shapes and bold, black contours. Ms. Cebular has crafted an oeuvre of stunning drawings which combine the desire for beauty with the artist need for expression which incite the senses and galvanize the spirits.
