Inspired by nature and color, Renata Cebular classifies herself as a 'drawing artist.' Renata works straight through when she is creating a piece, from the beginning until the end, using calligraphic markers and a white gel point pen to create a sense of movement which both connects to and transitions perfectly into her fashion creations.
